

MultiSurf Network License Instructions

There are two install files - one for the server and the other for the clients. If the server needs to run MultiSurf, both install files should be used on it.

Server Install Program: [RLMV12_Server64.exe](#)

1. Use the link above to download the network license install program file for your server.
2. Run the install program which will create a sub-folder **AeroHydro\License Info** in your "**\Users\User_Name\AppData\Roaming**" folder and copy some files to it. If a different location is desired, you will be prompted in the process for any change you require.
3. The install creates an RLM License Server and installs it as a service. If the service does not automatically start after the install program is finished, reboot your server to start the service.
4. Created in the previous step is a file called 'hostid.txt' located in the server's **\Users\User_Name\AppData\Roaming\AeroHydro\License Info** folder (or the folder you specified in the installation process).
5. Email the "hostid.txt" file to estanley@aerohydro.com so it can be used to generate your permanent license file.
6. Go to this address on your browser: http://<COMPUTER_NAME>:5054 to open the Server Admin Page. Bookmark this address.
7. A server and client license file will be returned. The server license file should be placed in the same folder specified during the installation procedure. Instructions for the client license file are provided below.
8. Go to the Server Admin on your browser as detailed in step 6. Click the Restart/Reread button, to enable the new license file.
9. The set up for the server should now be complete.

Now on to the client machine.

MultiSurf Solo/Standard Install Program: [multisurf90_428.exe](#)

1. Using the appropriate link above, download and install MultiSurf.
2. MultiSurf should run in evaluation mode for 21 days.
3. Included with a new license file for the server, will be an additional file for the client. Please place this file in the MultiSurf application folder.
4. Save the file and MultiSurf should open as a client.

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
